Since the State Heritage listing handed down by the Minister in June 2020, all has been quiet on the surface. However, a lot has been happening behind the stage.

Woollahra Council is still undeterred and is ploughing ahead with its plan – as approved by all 15 councillors.

The General Manager Mr Craig Swift McNair has advised that a consulting company has been commissioned to prepare a Conservation Management Strategy (CMS) for Rushcutters Bay Park to be tabled around June/July 2021.

Another possible way into the heritage listing is to dissect Section 60 of the Heritage Act 1977 to find a small gap to squeeze through and find a coma or two out place.

Council elections are in September 2021 and we all expect to have a new Council which will listen and care about residents' opinions instead of destroying our precious green and breathing space.
