FUNDING TO UPGRADE LOCAL CROWN LAND FACILITIES

Member for Vaucluse Gabrielle Upton MP announced that \$17 million has been reserved by the NSW Government to upgrade and improve Crown land.

Ms Upton said, “The Crown Reserves Improvement Fund can be used to support upgrades to facilities used by community organisations like surf lifesaving clubs, bowling clubs, showgrounds, scouts and local parks.

“To make the most of this funding, I strongly encourage local community groups who use Crown land and our local councils to apply for funding.

Minister for Lands and Water Kevin Anderson said Crown land plays a significant role within NSW communities and the Government is committed to providing the best facilities possible.

“These grants will help communities as they get back on their feet after Covid-19 and the floods by funding improvements to community, recreational and tourism facilities, while also supporting local businesses and economies within our regions.

Eligible applicants include community groups who use Crown land and for projects that can deliver social, cultural, environmental or economic benefits.
