REGULAR SYDNEY TRAIN SERVICES TO RESUME

Member for Vaucluse Gabrielle Upton announced that train services will return to a weekday timetable at the end of this month to keep up with a demand for services across the Greater Sydney rail network.

Ms Upton said, "From Monday 28 February the Monday to Friday weekday timetable on the Sydney Trains network will be reinstated so that residents have more options to get to work, school or whenever they need to go.

"In the past week the number of people using rail services has climbed seven per cent compared to the previous week, which is a good sign that people are beginning to resume their normal routines," Ms Upton said.

Transport for NSW Chief Operations Officer Howard Collins said safety across the network remains top priority.

"We will continue to implement our COVIDSafe Transport Plan to ensure frontline workers and customers who rely on public transport stay safe," Mr Collins said.

Masks are mandatory on public transport and green dots remain in place to guide customers on the best places to sit or stand on services.

All other modes of public transport will continue to run to an enhanced timetable except ferries, which have kept operating to their normal weekday timetable.
