

## Double Bay Wharf Upgrade – Project planning approval received

Following consideration of community and stakeholder feedback on the [Double Bay Wharf Upgrade](#) Review of Environmental Factors (REF), the project has received planning approval.

We thank the community for your feedback – it will help to inform the detailed design and construction of the project.

During consultation on the REF we received 20 submissions. The key feedback topics raised included:

- proposal design
- proposal justification
- transport, traffic and access
- landscape character and visual impacts
- biodiversity
- noise and vibration
- consultation
- construction impacts.

The detailed design process will begin shortly. Due to wharf component supply issues, and requests to construct the wharf outside of the summer months, construction is now expected to begin in the first half of 2023. Construction will take up to six months to complete (weather permitting).
