Woollahra Council Update - Exhibition of proposed DCP excavation amendments and Notification of 7.12 Plan

Good Morning,

Today we commenced public exhibition of <u>Draft Woollahra Development Control Plan</u> 2015 (Amendment 20).

The amendment seeks to enhance the existing excavation provisions to:

- Strengthen the objectives for excavation controls;
- Restrict certain types of works occurring in side setbacks; and
- Provide further clarity on documentation requirements.

The proposed amendments will affect Chapters A1 (Introduction) and B3 (General Development Controls) of the Woollahra Development Control Plan 2015.

The exhibition period will run from Wednesday 13 July 2022 to Friday 19 August 2022.

Additionally, the *Woollahra Section 7.12 Development Contributions Plan 2022* comes into effect today.

The approved plan, adopted by Council on 27 June 2022, applies to the entire Woollahra Local Government Area. It authorises a condition on a development consent (or complying development certificate), requiring the applicant to pay to Council a levy. Monies collected are applied to the provision, extension or augmentation of public facilities located in the LGA.

The Woollahra Section 7.12 Development Contributions Plan 2022 repealed the Section 7.12 Development Contributions Plan 2021 on its commencement.
